We are seeking applications for the position of Community Alcohol & Drug Support Service (CADSS) Project Coordinator / Clinician, to work within our Alcohol and Other Drug (ATOD) and Health Promotions Teams.

The position is based in the Circular Head, Waratah Wynyard and King Island municipalities, aiming to improve the health, social and family functioning of individuals who may be experiencing problems associated with substance misuse, enabling them to reach their full capacity and participate positively in their community by providing specialist ATOD services including:

- Specialist alcohol and other drug screening and brief intervention
- Specialist alcohol and other drug counselling
- Case management and aftercare through a 'HUB' model which provides a framework for collaborative practice between services to successfully deliver multi service, shared care arrangements.
- Outreach services - provided at either a neutral site or at the client's home or via digital technology to clients who cannot access on-site services.

The person we are looking for will be engaging and articulate, have tertiary qualifications in social welfare, or equivalent, and experience in ATOD counselling and case management.

To qualify for an interview applicants must have a current Driver's Licence AND a Working with Vulnerable People Registration, and be willing to undergo a pre-employment medical.
