CRISIS ACCOMMODATION SUPPORT SERVICE

The Crisis Accommodation Support Service (CASS) provides Emergency Crisis Accommodation to young people aged 13–20 years of age who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. CASS has two main goals. The first is to reunify the young person with their family of origin or extended family. If this isn't possible, the young person will be helped to find safe and secure independent accommodation.

TRANSITIONAL ACCOMMODATION SUPPORT SERVICE

The Transitional Accommodation Support Service (TASS) works with young people to make a successful transition into long term, safe, and affordable accommodation. TASS provides support for young people aged between 13–20 years of age, along with medium term/transitional accommodation for young people aged 15–20 years and young parents who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.
