4. Nominees may be nominated for several categories. A separate form must be completed for each category.
5. Nominees must be born between the years 2001 – 2008 (inclusive).
6. Nominees must live in, or have significant and demonstrable ties to one of the following local government areas: Latrobe, Kentish, Devonport, Central Coast, Burnie, Waratah-Wynyard, Circular Head, West Coast or King Island.
