- 4. Nominees can be nominated for one category only.
- 5. Nominees must be born between the years 2003 2010 (inclusive) or aged 13 20vrs.
- 6. Nominees must live in or have significant and demonstrable ties to one of the following local government areas: Latrobe, Kentish, Devonport, Central Coast, Burnie, Waratah-Wynyard, Circular Head, West Coast or King Island.
- 7. Nominations with insufficient contact details for nominee will not be accepted.
- 8. You may be broad with your reasoning if you wish to maintain an element of privacy for the nominee.

## **Award Category Descriptions**

### **High Five! Award**

The High Five is a long-standing tradition when it comes to celebrating an achievement – no matter how large or small. This your chance to give someone a public high five, so all of us can celebrate their achievement.
