This is a simple version of YFCC's Child Safe Policy. It is for children, young people, families, and visitors. It uses clear words to help everyone understand.

Our Promise

- YFCC will keep children and young people safe, respected and heard.
- We will follow the 10 Tasmanian Child and Youth Safe Standards and 10 National Principles to keep children safe.
- We have zero tolerance for child abuse.
- We include and protect all children – Aboriginal children, children from different cultures, children with disability, and LGBTQI+ children.
- We always put children first.

What We Believe

- Every child has the right to be safe and happy.
- Children's voices matter.
- Families and communities help keep children safe.
- We respect and value all children equally.

Who Must Follow This Policy

- All YFCC staff, volunteers, students, and workers.
- Board Members and leaders.
- Anyone working with children at YFCC.

What YFCC Workers Must Do

- Always put safety first.
- Make sure we do the right checks when we hire someone new.
- Ask questions and listen when children share worries.
- Respect privacy and keep personal information safe.
- Report if we see or hear about unsafe behaviour.
- Be role models with kind and respectful behaviour.
